

Osage Orange Sharpshooters Carbine Match Program

Sponsor: Osage Orange Sharpshooters, an affiliate of the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP)

Date, Time: July 17, 2010 7:55AM registration followed immediately by match.

Location: Dalton Range, Bois D'Arc Conservation Area, Greene County, Missouri

Competition open to: All CMP members and guests. CMP "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" must be signed or on file.

New Shooters: At their request, new shooter will have an experienced shooter assigned as coach. By pre-arrangement, loaner rifles and equipment will be available.

Coaching: is allowed and encouraged

Entry Fee: \$15, includes 50 rounds of .30 Carbine issued to each competitor for use in the match.

Registration: Pre-registration is not necessary.

Relays, Firing Points, and Range Operations: 20 firing points, 2 relays. Each relay will shoot the complete match before the next relay fires. Relay not firing will score and replace targets for firing relay. Competitors will help set up and clean up range

Rules: CMP rules for Carbine Match with this modification: physically challenged shooters will be exempted from standing before a rapid fire stage upon notification of the match director.

Rifles and Ammunition: As-issued M1 Carbines may be used. Only issued ammunition may be used in match.

Slow Fire Loading: To facilitate easy loading, competitors may load a magazine containing 5 rounds during slow fire. Special care must be taken in slow fire stages to keep the muzzle pointed downrange at all times. In the standing position, the muzzle may not be pointed in any other direction other than downrange while a magazine is inserted in the rifle.

Rapid Fire: When the "Load" command is given, the competitor will first close the bolt then load the magazine into the rifle. The competitor may not chamber a round from the magazine until he is in position (bottom, knee, or belly on the mat).

Match course: Carbine 40 shot course of fire at 100 yards:

Stage 1: 10 sighting shots in 10 minutes

Stage 2: 10 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 10 minutes, target SR-1

Stage 3: 10 shots for record, prone from standing, 60 seconds, mandatory reload, target SR-1

Stage 4: 10 shots for record, sitting or kneeling from standing, 60 seconds, mandatory reload, target SR-1

Stage 5: 10 shots for record, standing, slow fire, 10 minutes, target SR-1

Awards: CMP Achievement Medals given based on scores calculated by the CMP for 2010.
