

Osage Orange Sharpshooters Beginner's Match Program

Sponsor: Osage Orange Sharpshooters, an affiliate of the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP)

Date, Time: Saturday March 6, 2010, 7:55am registration followed immediately by match.

Location: Dalton Range, Bois D'Arc Conservation Area, Greene County, Missouri

Competition open to: All CMP members and guests. CMP "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" must be signed or on file.

New Shooters: At their request, new shooter will have an experienced shooter assigned as coach. By pre-arrangement, loaner rifles and equipment will be available.

Coaching: is allowed and encouraged

Entries: No fee. Registration on day of match.

Range Operation: Competitors will help set up and clean up range.

Relays and Firing Points: 20 firing points, 2 relays. Each relay will shoot the complete match before the next relay fires. Relay not firing will score and replace targets for firing relay.

Rules: CMP rules for John C. Garand Match with these modifications: 1) Rapid fire prone time will be 70 seconds for all shooters; 2) Physically challenged shooters will be exempted from standing before a rapid fire stage upon notification of the match director.

Rifles: As-issued military rifles legal for any CMP games may be used (M1 Garand, M1 Carbine, 1903 or 03A3 Springfield, M1917, or foreign bolt rifles. In addition, semi-auto rifles of the AK or SKS families may be used with iron sights. Other rifles may be allowed providing they are the equivalent of a WWII military rifle in accuracy.

Ammunition: Competitors supply own ammunition. Surplus .30-06 M2 Ball available for purchase.

Match course: CMP G-S-M 30 shot course of fire at 100 yards:

Stage 1: 5 sighting shots in 5 minutes

Stage 2: 10 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 20 minutes, target SR-1

Stage 3: 10 shots for record, sitting from standing, 60 seconds, mandatory reload, target SR-1

Stage 4: 10 shots for record, standing, slow fire, 10 minutes, target SR-1

Out of Competition Shooters: Competitors may choose to shoot NRA reduced-course highpower targets (SR-1, SR-21, MR-31) with any rifle/any sight. These participants will not be included in the awards.

Awards: CMP Achievement Medals given based on scores calculated by the CMP for 2010 JCG Match
