

Osage Orange Sharpshooters Springfield/Vintage Match Program

Sponsor: Osage Orange Sharpshooters, an affiliate of the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP)

Date, Time: Saturday May 8, 2010 7:55 am registration followed immediately by match.

Location: Dalton Range, Bois D'Arc Conservation Area, Greene County, Missouri

Competition open to: All CMP members and guests. CMP "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" must be signed or on file.

New Shooters: At their request, new shooter will have an experienced shooter assigned as coach. By pre-arrangement, loaner rifles and equipment will be available.

Coaching: is allowed and encouraged

Entry Fee: \$15, includes 55 rounds of .30-06 issued to each competitor for use in the match. Vintage and Foreign Military Rifle shooters may decline the ammunition and the entry fee will be waived.

Registration: Pre-registration is not necessary.

Relays, Firing Points, and Range Operations: 20 firing points, 2 relays. Each relay will shoot the complete match before the next relay fires. Relay not firing will score and replace targets for firing relay. Competitors will help set up and clean up range

Rules: CMP rules for Springfield and Vintage/Foreign Military Rifle Match except that physically challenged shooters will be exempted from standing before a rapid fire stage upon notification of the match director.

Rifles and Ammunition: As-issued M1903 or 1903A3 rifles are in the Springfield category, while Krag and M1917 rifles are in the Vintage category along with all Foreign Military bolt rifles. Springfield rifles may only use issued ammunition. Vintage and Foreign Military rifles will provide their own ammunition.

Match course: CMP As-Issued 50 shot course of fire at 100 yards:

Stage 1: 5 sighting shots in 5 minutes

Stage 2: 20 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 20 minutes, target SR-1

Stage 3: 10 shots for record, prone from standing, 80 seconds, mandatory reload, target SR-1

Stage 4: 10 shots for record, sitting from standing, 70 seconds, mandatory reload, target SR-1

Stage 5: 10 shots for record, standing, slow fire, 10 minutes, target SR-1

Awards: CMP Achievement Medals given based on scores calculated by the CMP for 2010.
